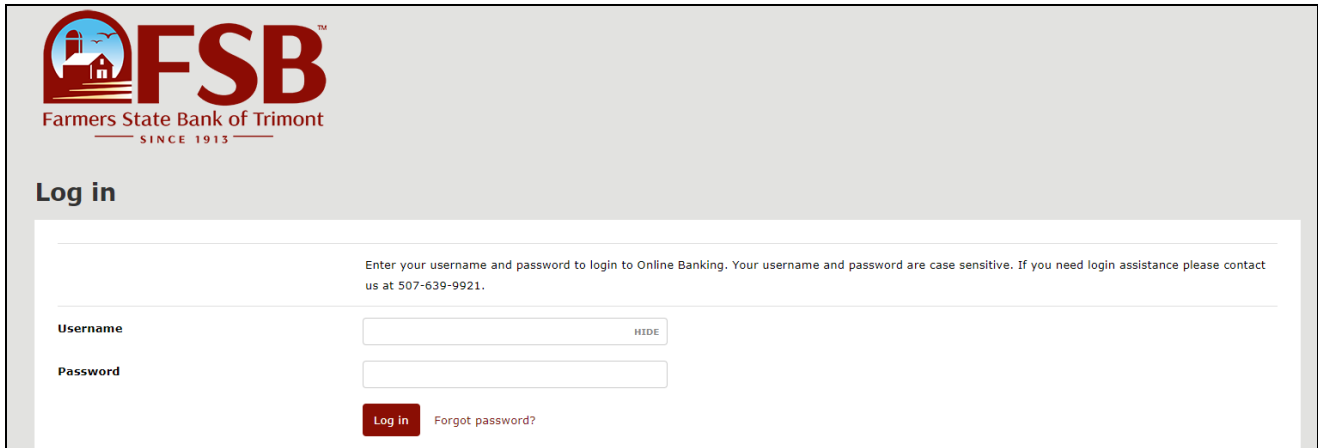
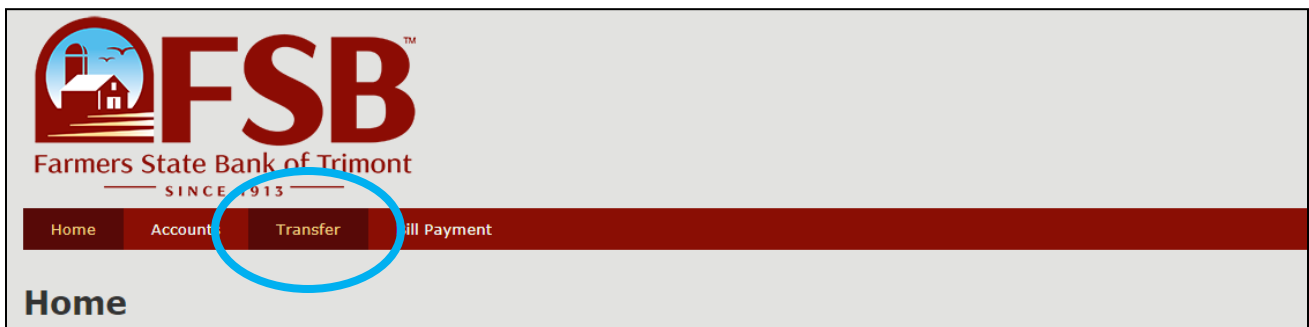


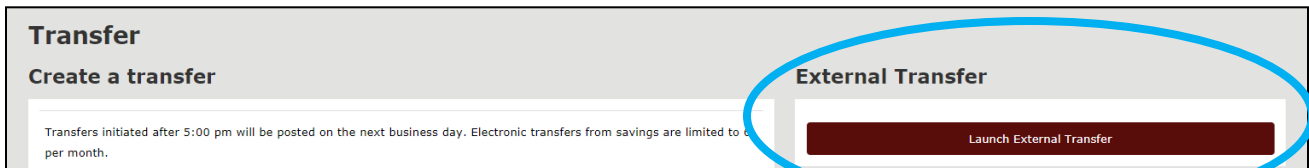
How to Set Up An External Transfer in Internet Banking



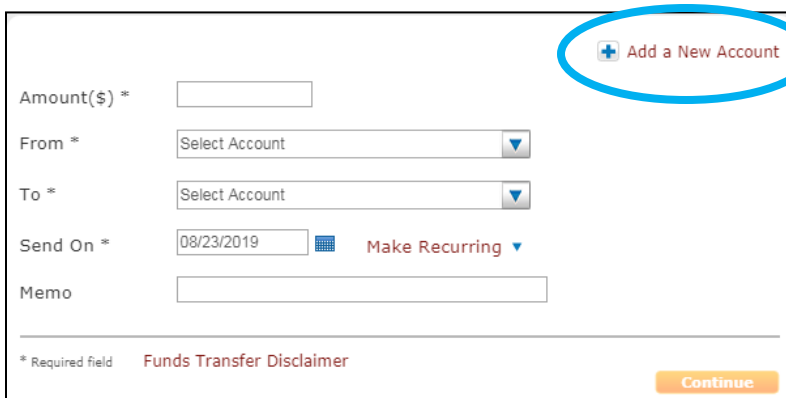
1. Log into Internet Banking (go to www.TrimontBank.com, click on “Internet Banking”, and the login screen will open).

3. Click on “Launch External Transfer”.

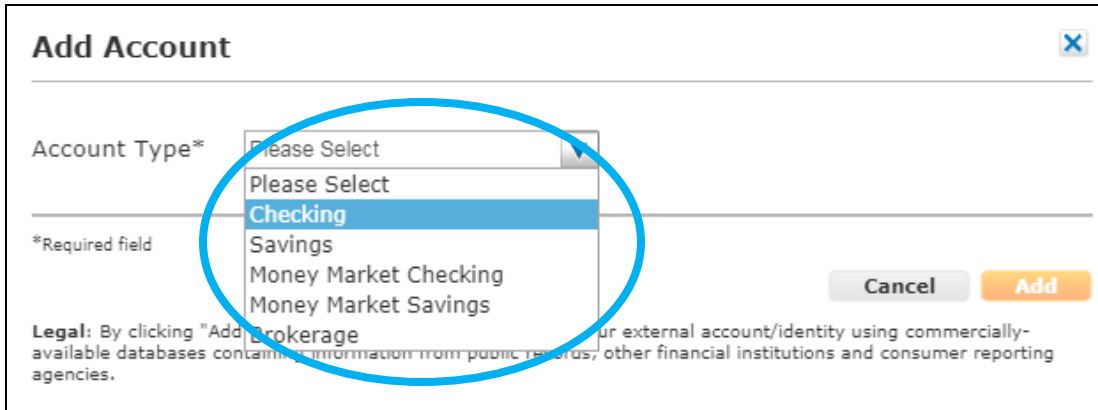


4. Click on “Add a New Account”.

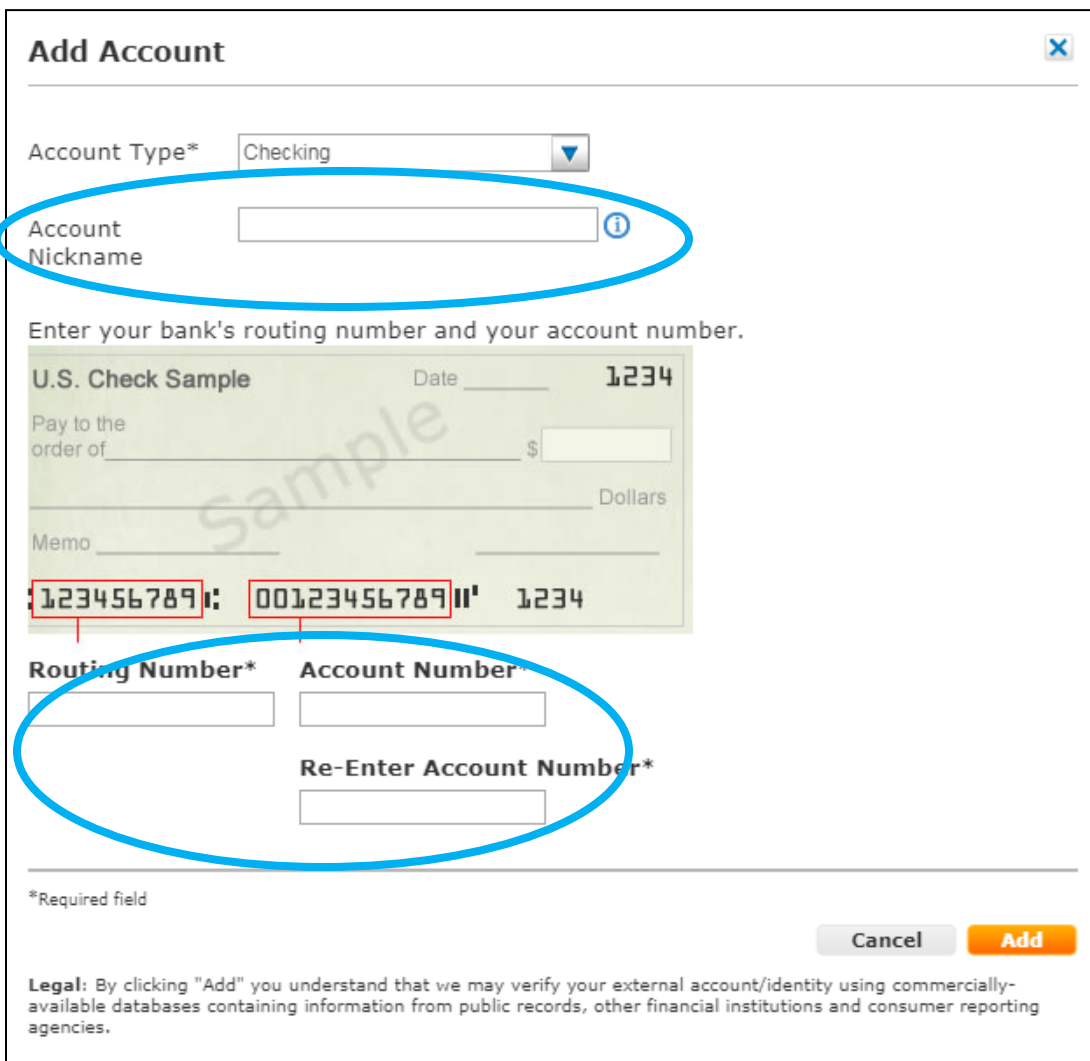
